



If you are between the ages of 18-60 and have NEVER registered before, please read the following before completing your paperwork.

In order to help ensure the safety of donors and recipients the National Marrow Program has established guidelines for potential donors. Please keep reading to determine if you are eligible for blood stem cell/ marrow donation.

If you have ever had any of the following diseases or conditions, you are ineligible to donate marrow.

Aids/ HIV
Asthma (requiring daily medication)
Autoimmune disorders
Back/Neck Surgery within last 5yrs
Disc Problem
Cancer
Diabetes (using Insulin)
Epilepsy
Heart disease/ surgery
High Blood Pressure (uncontrolled)
Hip replacement
Organ Transplant recipient
Osteoporosis
Rheumatoid arthritis
Sickle cell anemia

***There are exceptions. See a recruiter**
